9. What revelations are given to Abram while he is asleep? What is significant about these and why would God reveal them now? What assurance would this give Abram, if any?

10. What does this passage teach us about "waiting upon the promises of God?"

- 2. How does this passage help you to understand the nature of faith in God?
- 3. Based on this study, have you learned new insights into God's character?
